#### ACTIVITIES and ACHIEVEMENTS

The grant is currently supporting our ongoing malnutrition prevention and treatment programme. During the first three months of implementation, activities were conducted as planned with the following achievements:

#### Children care:

Screening for cases of moderate and severe acute malnutrition (MAM-SAM) was conducted on a daily basis in our catchment area:

- 365 children (168 boys and 197 girls) were screened.
- 36 children (17 boys and 19 girls) were referred to St. Mary Hospital for official diagnosis of malnutrition: 6 cases of MAM (4 boys and 2 girls) and 18 cases of SAM (12 boys and 6 girls) were confirmed.
- 20 children (12 boys and 8 girls) have been admitted to BJCL malnutrition rehabilitation centre and are receiving care.

#### Parents' support:

- 1 health education session was organized for 52 parents (2 male and 52 female) of children admitted to BJCL.
- 6 rounds of food distributions were made (once every other week) to 11 households, with a total of 820 kg of maize and 164 kg of beans being delivered.

11 mothers of children already discharged from BJCL are attending the livelihood support programme and are being trained on how to set up a small business. 3 of them have already started their own income generating activity.

Activities are being monitored through field visits report, medical records from St. Mary Hospital and BJCL, and livelihood reports. Programme updates are shared on a weekly basis during management meetings, so that challenges in the implementation can be identified and addressed timely.

The programme impact will be assessed through the data and feedback collected during the follow up visits to children and parents after completing the rehabilitation period and the livelihood support respectively, as well as by comparing each year's outputs and outcomes with those of previous years.

#### Financial statement

Funds were used as planned to cover salaries of part of the staff supervising the programme and coordinating the activities, to purchase supplies to deliver the activities, and transport costs for field visits.

Unfortunately the economic situation in the country remains unstable, with fluctuating inflation and devaluation of the Ethiopian Birr affecting negatively our purchasing power.

In order to mitigate the impact on the implementation of the project, we have opted for bulk purchase in advance of non perishable items. However, many items are already much more expensive than what budgeted for.
